# ANNUAL FEES NOW DUE AFTER YEAR OF FREE MEMBERSHIP!

As of April, 2021, MonSFFA has officially resumed the collection of annual membership fees. Club members are asked to mail their cheques or money orders, made out to "MonSFFA," to our *new* postal mailing address.

Because of the lockdowns and other COVID-19 safety measures imposed by authorities beginning early last year, and continuing still, the club has been unable to hold any of its usual meetings and events. No indoor gatherings in particular, like our monthly meetings, are currently permitted and we estimate that it will be several months yet before things get back to something approaching normal.

So as not to sideline ourselves completely during quarantine, we introduced a series of "DIY, Virtual MonSFFA Meetings," hosted monthly on the club's Web site, the first of these having unfolded on April 4, 2020. To date, we've hosted 13 such online gatherings, which now include a Zoom get-together running in parallel.

With the club unable to offer a full slate of activities, however, MonSFFA's Executive opted to also suspend the collection of annual membership fees. So effectively, during the past approximately 12 months, MonSFFen have enjoyed a fees-free year of club membership!

During that year, the club, of course, collected no revenue whatsoever. Nothing. Nada. Not so much as a nickel! We had to cancel our usually lucrative November sci-fi book sale, and we've been unable to benefit even from the modest income normally generated by small fund-raising raffles and our snack table, staples of the club's regular meetings. While we have not been shelling out for the major expense of renting physical meeting space, we are still incurring costs for fanzine printings, the Web site, postal mailings, and now for a Zoom subscription which allows us to hold our extended video chats as part of each month's e-meeting.

## An Unprecedented, Nightmarish Year for Us All!

Impulse last published over a year ago, in the early weeks of the COVID-19 pandemic that took hold of not only our city, but the entire province, country, and indeed, the whole world, an event unprecedented in any of our lifetimes.

The club had just cancelled all of its upcoming meetings and events as public health authorities imposed lockdowns across Québec and the rest of Canada in an attempt to mitigate the rapid spread of this novel coronavirus, designated SARS-CoV-2 and known colloquially as COVID-19.

MonSFFA, along with much of society, was suddenly rendered inert as the deadly virus proliferated, shuttering schools, disrupting commerce, and overwhelming hospitals. Panic set in among many. We all thought—hoped!—that the summer sun would bring relief, and it did, to a certain degree. But a second wave of infection soon exploded, and earlier this year, a third. For the better part of a year, now, the virus has remained at least one step ahead of the best efforts of medical science.
