Lies, Damned Lies and Statistics

The following is a complete voting breakdown of ballots submitted for the 2022 FAAn awards (for work first published in 2021).

The recipient of the LIfetime Achievement Award for 2022 will be announced at Corflu Pangloss in October.

66 ballots were received. No entire ballots were rejected for any reason. One unsigned ballot received by regular mail had votes rejected in three categories: 'Special Publication' which named an individual and not a publication, 'Fanartist' which was illegible, and 'Fanzine Cover' which named a title but no issue number. Despite the administrator's inability to seek clarification (having no return address), votes in the 'Fanwriter' category were legible and were counted. One ballot contained a 'Fanzine Cover' vote for a nonexistent publication. The voter was notified, dropped this selection and declined to make a substitution. Two ballots included 'Fanzine Cover' votes for publications from prior to 2021, which were rejected; those voters were notified, one made a substitution and the other did not. One other 'Fanzine Cover' vote simply named an artist without specifying a particular issue, but the voter later corrected this. The same voter submitted the selection of a novel for 'Special Publication', which was also ruled out. One ballot included a vote

for 'Best Fanwriter' established, after query, to be based solely on a reprint piece. Unable to cite first published work in 2021 for the writer, this was removed by the voter.

"Top choice" designations were confirmed, where needed, with several voters, but in general ranking numbered choices submitted were considered to specify the #1 as "top choice", and unranked ballots were not. Various methods were employed by voters to indicate a specified "top choice", including ranking, asterisks, exclamation marks and so forth, with clear intent.

Octothorpe gets a paragraph all its own. One vote for that podcast as a perzine was rejected on the grounds that it's not a fanzine, despite arguments that it is an "artifact" as described in the definitions used. The administrator's opinion is that it cannot be said to be "published" (as also stated in the definition), which in the context of the awards clearly suggests voters should infer a written (rather than spoken) product. This is fully in the spirit of awards intended to honor fanzine publications. Similarly, a vote for the podcast as a genzine was also rejected. Three votes were also received for 'Fanzine Cover' for various episodes, and were rejected, one of which was in any case from 2022. The specific voters were notified of these decisions. Further discussion on this topic is welcomed, and will be occurring in the pages of This Here..., so any comments received as a result of these decisions will be published there unless the correspondent(s) specifically request otherwise.

One additional note on attribution: although the editorship of the fanthology *Daangerous Visions* was credited to **Sandra Bond**, she specifically requested that the 'boo should be shared with **Rob Jackson** and **Pat Virzi**, and so it is.

Thanks to: All who participated, particularly those who also engaged in awareness efforts; to **Jerry Kaufman** for again agreeing to ably present the awards at the Corflu Zoom ceremonies. **Very** special thanks as always to **Bill Burns** for unstinting encouragement, solid advice and continued support both privately and via efanzines; also **Justin E.A. Busch** and **Mark Plummer** for valuable contributions to the compilation of the 2021 listings. NUMBER ONE FAN FACE TALLY

"Number One Fan Face" is an additional award first given in 1998, but hasn't been given every year since then. Recent years have determined the award by aggregating votes or points received in all categories of the FAAn awards, and I continue to follow this method. Co-edited fanzines have their full vote total allocated to each co-editor. Bonus points for top choice are not included. Here are the top ten aggregate vote getters (coincidentally also those with an aggregate over 30): The legend in the following table, in case it isn't obvious: GZ (Genzine), PZ (Perzine), SP (Special Publication), FW (Fanwriter), FA (Fanartist), HW (Harry Warner, Jr. letterhack award), C (Fanzine Cover).
