- **Addison, Katherine. THE TOMB OF DRAGONS. [THE CEMETERIES OF AMALO #3]. Tor, 25.99 tp.**

Thara Celehar has lost his ability to speak with the dead. When that title of Witness for the Dead is gone, what defines him? While his title may be gone, his duties are not. Celehar contends with a municipal cemetery with fifty years of secrets, the damage of a revethavar he's terrified to remember, and a group of miners who are more than willing to trade Celehar's life for a chance at what they feel they're owed.

- **Alongi, C. M. THE WITCH WHO TRADES WITH DEATH. Angry Robot, 26.99 tp.**

All witches must serve the cruel and immortal Emperor Yamueto. But after four years of terror and abuse, Khana not only kills one of his favorite courtiers with her magic, but also discovers the secret of his power and immortality. He's been making deals with Death. And now, so is she. Armed with magic that she doesn't fully understand, Khana flees the empire and stumbles into a small mountain town filled with fierce warriors that ostracize her for being a witch, despite using her abilities to heal their sick and injured.

- **Asher, E. B. THIS WILL BE INTERESTING. Avon, 25.99 tp.**

An unlikely band of heroes must get to the bottom of an assassination plot gone wrong without breaking the one rule of questing: do not fall in love with your questmates.

- **Aster, Alex. STARSIDE. Avon, 42.00 hc.**

Starside is the realm of magic and immortals living in a power-rich paradise. Stormside is where mortals fight for scraps of that magic. Every fifty years, the gates between them open, and fifty challengers are allowed to journey across Starside on a deadly quest to access a pool of magic that can heal, grant wealth, or extend life. Everyone has their reasons for entering, but Aris has only one: vengeance.

- **Bear, Lauren J. A. MOTHER OF ROME. Ace, 27.00 tp.**

Beautiful, royal, rich: Rhea has it all - until her father loses his kingdom in a treacherous coup, and she is sent to the order of the Vestal Virgins to ensure she will never produce an heir. Except when mortals scheme, gods laugh. Rhea becomes pregnant, and human society turns against her. Abandoned, ostracized, and facing the gravest punishment, Rhea forges a dangerous deal with the divine, one that will forever change the trajectory of her life...and her beloved land.

- **Binge, Nicholas. DISSOLUTION. Riverhead, 26.00 tp.**

Meanwhile, in the Fey lands, Aefe has been dragged back into this world by a king who vows to destroy civilizations in her name.

- **Brom. EVIL IN ME. Nightfire, 27.99 tp.**

Brom's newest novel of possession, damnation, and rock 'n' roll where one woman must get the world singing in order to save her soul. This devilish tale includes nearly two dozen of Brom's immersive paintings.

[Canadian author] Daye was woven together from flowers and magic to be the perfect playmate for Rory, a young boy left isolated in a remote country estate. In the early years, their friendship, almost eerily in sync, is everything the two lonely children could dream of. But the threat of Daye literally - and gruesomely - falling apart whenever the seasons change drives Rory to learn ever deeper and stranger magic, until the line between what he can do and what he should do begins to blur.

- **Green, Ian. EXTREMOPHILE. AdAstra, 24.99 tp.**

Charlie and Parker are punks by night, biohackers by day, living in the stuttering decay of near-future climate-collapse London. Best friends JP and Dulin join Canterbury Trail Tours and an assortment of 21st century pilgrims for a week-long bus tour of North America's Impossibles, the physics-defying glitches and geographic miracles that started cropping up seven years earlier - right after the Announcement that revealed our world to be merely a digital simulacrum.

- **Hair, David. THE FALLING SKY. [THE TALMONT TRILOGY #3]. Mobius, 36.00 hc.**

Romara Challys and her Falcons have suffered for the truth, enduring vast journeys across a disintegrating world to uncover the suicidally destructive nature of elobyne, the energy crystals that are both the magical power upholding the Triple Empire, and the reason that same empire is racing toward environmental catastrophe. They have found new allies, other ways to channel magic, and exposed a deadly cabal of puppet-masters - the "angelic" Alephi - who secretly rule the empire. Those successes will be their destruction.

- **Hamm, Emma. THE HEARTLESS ONE. [THE GRAVESINGER #2]. Gallery, 26.00 tp.**

Now that Elric has returned to his corporeal form and Jessamine has joined the coven of witches that sustain his power, the two are stronger than ever. But the kingdom is still in turmoil. They must prepare their coven of witches to meet the

kingdom's forces in battle - before the man who has usurped her throne learns how to harness the power of Elric's fellow gods.

- **Haynes, Natalie. NO FRIEND TO THIS HOUSE. Harper, 28.99 tp.**

Medea - priestess, witch, and daughter of a brutal king - has the power to save the life of a stranger. Will she betray her family and her home, and what will she demand in return? Medea and Jason seize their one chance of a life together, as the gods intend. But their love is steeped in vengeance from the beginning, and no one - not even those closest to them - will be safe.

- **Hess, Al. SHAKE OUT THE GHOSTS. Angry Robot, 26.99 tp.**

A brutal assault left eccentric portrait artist Micah with facial scars and PTSD. He believes his apartment is haunted by Cosmo, the deceased previous tenant. And when Cosmo's ghostly visits suddenly stop, Micah is determined to lure him back. Meanwhile, sculpture artist Cosmo, every much alive, is mourning his old self. To make matters worse, his apartment is being haunted by the ghost of a bespectacled man with an eye socket of scars. It's the last straw, and seeking a new start, Cosmo moves out. Later, in a chance meeting, Cosmo and Micah's paths will cross again.

- **Howard, Amalie. QUEEN OF THE NIGHT SKY. [STARKEEPER #2]. Avon, 25.99 tp.**

When an attempt on her life leads to her rescue on the back of an azdaha, the dragon-like creature she once thought a myth, Sura finds herself in a land far beyond Oryndhyr's borders. Everlea is full of magic, ruled by the deadly and enigmatic Night King, Darrius. And to Sura's shock, Darrius is none other than the man in her dreams...and possibly her soul fated mate. As a prophecy unfolds, the old gods awaken, and a war between kingdoms looms, Sura has no choice: she must fully embrace her destiny as Starkeeper and the entirety of her power before it's too late.

- **Ibson, Jamie (ed). PLAUSIBLY DENIABLE. Baen, 25.00 tp.**

In Plausibly Deniable, we get a peek behind the curtain. We get to see what shouldn't be seen, to know what they don't want you to know, and to find out the true story of whodunnit. Stories from Jody Lynn Nye, Michael Z. Williamson, Jason Cordova, Jacob Holo, Kacey Ezell, Marisa Wolf and more.

- **Johnson, Julie. THE WIND WEAVER. [REIGN OF REMNANTS #1]. Ace, 25.99 tp.**

Romantasy. Fear of magic plagues war-torn Anwyvyn. Halflings like Rhya Fleetwood are killed on sight. But Rhya's execution is interrupted by an unexpected saviour - one far more terrifying than her would-be killers. The mysterious and mercenary Commander Scythe. In the clutches of this new enemy, Rhya finds herself fighting for her life in the barren reaches of the Northlands. Yet the farther she gets from home, the more she learns that nothing is as it seems - not her fearsome captor, not the blight that ravages her dying realm, not even herself.

- **Jordahl, Anneli. THE BEAR HUNTER'S DAUGHTERS: A TALE OF SEVEN SISTERS. HarperVia, 24.00 tp.**

Deep in the woods of western Finland, a bear hunter has raised his seven daughters to live off the land and steer clear of the trappings of life in town, like cell phones and a social life outside their family. When on his youngest Elga's twelfth birthday the hunter is killed by his prey, and their mother dies soon thereafter, the sisters are left with unpaid bills and a leaky house. The tension between sticking to the wild ways their father taught them and submitting to well-meaning townsfolk's efforts to "help" threatens to divide the seven sisters.

- **Josephson, Kalyn. THE LIBRARY OF AMORLIN. [THE AGE OF BEASTS #1]. Erewhon, 42.00 hc.**

Kasira used to be a masterful con artist: choosing her target, building trust, judging the precise moment to make her move. Now, she's working off a lengthy prison sentence by hunting dangerous magical creatures on behalf of the fanatical kingdom of Kalthos. But Kasira's past catches up to her when the ambassador from Kalthos arrives at her camp with a deal: her freedom in exchange for infiltrating and destabilizing the magical institution meant to protect all six kingdoms - the Library of Amorlin.

- **Kalfar, Jaroslav. A BRIEF HISTORY OF LIVING FOREVER. Back Bay, 24.99 tp.**

When Adela discovers she has a terminal illness, her thoughts turn to Tereza, the American-raised daughter she gave up at birth. Leaving behind her moody, grown son, Roman, in their native Czech village, she flies to the United States to find the long-lost daughter who never knew her. Yet the country, in the year 2029, is steeped in surveillance and has adopted an unapologetic nationalism - a very different place from the open and accepting one Adela experienced decades earlier, when, as a teenager high on the promise of America, she eloped with a filmmaker and starred in his cult sci-fi movie.

- **Kelk, Lindsey. WITCH AND THE WOLF. [SAVANNAH RED #2]. Magpie, 21.99 tp.**

Faced with the absence of her love, Wynn, as he wrestles with his new abilities as a werewolf, and burdened with the task of finding her fellow witches to avert the prophecy that surrounds her, Emily is attacked by a new threat. A lone wolf that will stop at nothing to destroy her. Emily must act fast and find out the wolf's identity before it kills her and all those she cares about.

- **Kingfisher, T. WOLF WORM. Nightfire, 41.99 hc.**

1899. Though Sonia Wilson is a talented scientific illustrator, she is only able to follow her dream because of her father's reputation as a renowned scientist, and after his death, she is left without work, prospects, or hope. So when the reclusive Dr. Halder offers her a position illustrating his vast collection of insects, Sonia jumps at the chance to move to his North Carolina manor house and put her talents to use. But with the aid of the housekeeper and a local healer, Sonia discovers that Halder's entomological studies have taken him down a twisted road.

- **Kingsley, Hannah. SOUL BOUND. [SOUL HATE #2]. One More Chapter, 23.99 tp.**

The Holy States have excommunicated Halice and recalled its Holy Servants, and blocked trade to the wounded city. Renza Di Maneri and her fellow members of the High Chamber are running out of time and have few good options. So when Renza's Soulhate, Idris Patricelli, suggests inviting mercenaries behind the city walls, in a bid to secure protection against Halice's righteous foe, she is forced to agree.

- **Knighton, Andrew. FORGED FOR ROYALTY. [FORGED FOR DESTINY #3]. Orbit, 25.99 tp.**

As Raul fights battle after battle using his newly acquired abilities, he comes to a decision about whether or not to take the throne of Estis for himself or put his fake destiny aside and let another become king.

- **Lakshminarayan, Lavanya. INTERGALACTIC FEAST. [FLAVOUR HACKER #2]. Solaris, 25.99 tp.**

It has been three months since Saraswati Kaveri and Serenity Ko won Interstellar MegaChef with their groundbreaking new food simulation, Feast. But victory is only the beginning. Saras is busy promoting their invention as the public face of Feast, while Ko keeps fighting battles to steer its development at XP Inc. And then there's the kiss. They've decided to just be friends for now, at least until the sim's impending launch, but the memory of that heady night hangs over them.

- **Lawrence, Mark. DAUGHTER OF CROWS. [THE ACADEMY OF KINDNESS #1]. Ace, 41.99 hc.**

The Academy of Kindness exists to create agents of retribution, cast in the image of the Furies - known as the kindly ones - against whom even the gods hesitate to stand. Each year a hundred girls are sold to the Academy. Ten years later only three will emerge. The Academy's halls run with blood. The few that survive its decade-long nightmare have been forged on the sands of the Wound Garden. They have learned ancient secrets amid the necrotic fumes of the Bone Garden. They leave its gates as avatars of vengeance, bound to uphold the oldest of laws. Only the most desperate would sell their child to the Kindnesses. But Rue ... she sold herself.

- **Lawrence, Mark. THE BOOK THAT HELD HER HEART. [THE LIBRARY TRILOGY #3]. Ace, 27.00 tp.**

Hungry for connection, Thora befriends Olea through the garden gate and their relationship quickly and intensely blossoms. Intoxicated, Thora throws herself into finding a cure for Olea's ailment and sinks deeper into a world of beauty, poison and obsession.

- **McGuire, Seanan. BUTTERFLY EFFECTS. [INCRYPTID #15]. Tor, 28.99 tp.**

Mama's soft-spoken, vegan daughter - everything dangerous about her is cut out. But when Tam's estranged Aunt Tigress is found murdered and skinned, Tam inherits an undead fox in a shoebox, and an ensemble of old enemies.

- **Reid, Ava. INNAMORATA. [THE HOUSE OF TEETH DUOLOGY #1]. Del Rey, 44.00 hc.**

Though she has not spoken a word in seven years, Lady Agnes is the true carrier of the House of Teeth's legacy. And she has her orders. She must recapture the secrets of death magic and avenge her family's fallen honor. She must arrange the betrothal of her beloved cousin Marozia to Liuprand, heir to the conqueror's throne, for access to the forbidden library in his grotesquely grand castle. Revenge burns in Agnes's heart but so do stranger passions - and it is Liuprand, the golden prince, who speaks to her soul.

- **Scieszka, Casey. THE FOUNTAIN. Harper, 37.99 hc.**

After nearly two centuries - an endless sequence of unnoticed, meaningless lives and a soul-shaking incident in the desert - she longs to be released. Posing as a newly arrived forest ranger, she quickly blends into the upstate community and learns of something curious and disturbing.

Ingram receives an impossible message: he, a fugitive and exile from Clan Camp-Bel, is desperately needed by the Clan in distant Aegeia, a thousand miles and more away, for a mission so secret it cannot be included in the recall. And the very night he and Quester set out, Urelle Vantage discovers there are assassins already on their trail and rushes to warn them - and following her, her aunt Lady Victoria, a retired Adventurer forced once more into the field.

- **Spoor, Ryk E. THE SPEAR OF ATHENA. [GODSWAR #2]. Histria, 26.99 tp.**

The four adventurers had barely survived the assassination attempts of the false Ares. - **Swallow, James. TOWARD THE NIGHT. [STAR TREK: STRANGE NEW WORLDS]. Pocket, 26.00 tp.**

Captain Christopher Pike and the USS Enterprise crew venture to the edge of the Klingon Empire, where they uncover mysterious subspace echoes near a volatile "flare star" dangerously located in a disputed area of the star system. As the Enterprise diverts from its course to track the echoes, Spock leads a daring landing party to investigate the source of the subspace echoes, navigating dangerous ionic radiation that renders the Enterprise's transporters too risky to use.

- **Tamaki, A. S. THE BOOK OF FALLEN LEAVES. Orbit, 25.99 tp.**

Sen Hoshiakari is an exiled prince of a clan that lost everything in his father's failed rebellion. Rui is a peasant girl who saved Sen's life on the night his family were put to the sword. But now, she is adrift and unsure of her place in the world, not knowing that the gods themselves have plans for her. As civil war throws the empire into chaos, and demons seek vengeance on the living, Sen and Rui must fight for both their clan and their shared future.

- **Taylor, Travis S. APOGEE. [BALLISTIC #2]. Baen, 37.00 hc.**

Marcus Dorman's network stretches across continents, threading together energy infrastructure, neural implants, and a constellation of secret quantum satellites. From deserts to orbit, the Hot Eagle One Task Force races to stop Dorman's next move: a quantum rendering system seeded with mRNA-linked human minds and powered by sleeper nodes across the planet. Somewhere inside a sensory deprivation tank, Dorman floats - rewriting reality one connection at a time, as astronauts battle in space, mercenaries clash in the Mongolian steppe, and a mysterious third faction watches from the shadows.

- **Tchaikovsky, Adrian. SHROUD. Tor UK, 21.99 tp.**

Rex is a good dog. Rex is also seven foot tall at the shoulder, bulletproof, bristling with heavy calibre weaponry and his voice resonates with subsonics especially designed to instil fear. With Dragon, Honey and Bees, he's part of a Multiform Assault Pack operating in the lawless anarchy of Campeche, Mexico. A genetically engineered Bioform, he's a deadly weapon in a dirty war. All he wants to be is a Good Dog. And to do that he must do exactly what Master says and Master says he's got to kill a lot of enemies.

- **Tchaikovsky, Adrian. BEAR HEAD. [DOGS OF WAR #2]. AdAstra, 24.99 tp (reissue).**

Jimmy Martin has a sore head. He's used to smuggling illegal data in his headspace. But this is the first time it has started talking to him. The data claims to be a distinguished academic, author and civil rights activist. It also claims to be a bear. A bear named Honey. And out in the airless Martian desert there is another presence. A novel intelligence, elusive, unknowable and potentially lethal. And Honey is here to make contact with it, whether Jimmy likes it or not.

But the siege has dragged into winter. Within the city, Devil Jack, a good man apprenticed to the notorious conjurer known as the Widow, is driven to bargaining with hell to get back what he's lost. - **Tse, Dorothy. CITY LIKE WATER. Graywolf, 22.00 tp.**

The city you grew up in is gone, as if sunk to the bottom of the ocean. So much has vanished with it - classmates, teachers, counterfeit watches, the erotic toe cleavage that used to lead the way down secret passages. People seem to keep disappearing. As he dives deeper into his investigation, he encounters danger at every turn, from physical altercations to supernatural threats.

- **Waite, Olivia. NOBODY'S BABY. [DOROTHY GENTLEMAN #2]. Tor.com, 34.99 hc.**

Dorothy Gentleman, ship's detective for HMS Fairweather, Her Majesty's most luxurious interstellar passenger liner, is put to the test once again when an infant is mysteriously left on her nephew's doorstep. Fertility is supposed to be on pause during the Fairweather's journey across the stars - but humans have a way of breaking any rule you set them. This year, the event was held at the Universal Hilton in Universal City, California. Hosted by Joel McHale, the Saturns were presented online by the organization itself for the first time. In the past, the event was televised on Electric, the online network co-founded by producer Dean Devlin. This year, the Academy opted to set up their own broadcast.

In addition to the traditional awards categories, special Saturn Awards were given to honor influential creators and landmark works. The Saturn Hall of Fame Award commemorated the 60th anniversary of *Star Trek*, and was accepted by William Shatner, Rod Roddenberry, and Alex Kurtzman with presentations from Jonathan Frakes, Brent Spiner, and Robert Picardo. Numerous cast members from across the various series and films were also in attendance on stage during the acceptance speech by Kurtzman.

George Lucas was presented with the Dr. Donald A Reed Founder's Award to honor his influence on the genre and lasting impact on cinema. The award was presented by Mark Hamill.

Guillermo del Toro presented the George Pal Memorial Award, in recognition of the 40th anniversary of *Aliens*, to James Cameron, Gale Anne Hurd, and Michael Biehn, with members of the cast in attendance.

The Lance Reddick Legacy Award, recognizing an actor's long-standing contributions to genre storytelling, was presented to Titus Welliver by Laurence Fishburne. The Robert Forster Artist's Award was handed to writer-producer Terry Matalas by Paul Bettany, honoring Matalas' creative leadership in science fiction television. And the Spotlight Award recognized the cast and crew of *The Boys*.

Saturn winner Tom Cruise presented the Visionary Award to writer-director Christopher McQuarrie for his work as a writer, director, and producer.
